

EXECUTIVE LOUNGE



OUT AND ABOUT


Hilton Nagasaki is located in the part of the city centred on Nagasaki Station. This is the point of departure for public transport facilities including JR (Japan Railway) trains, city trams, and buses, providing easy access to tourist sites.

Nagasaki Seaside Park: A richly wooded park that looks out onto the port of Nagasaki, where ships are constantly entering and departing. Nagasaki Prefectural Art Museum: This museum's collection includes Spanish art and works connected with Nagasaki. Oura Church (Basilica): This is Japan's oldest church, where 26 Japanese martyrs of the Christian faith are enshrined. The building has been designated as a National Treasure and UNESCO Cultural Heritage Site. Glover Garden: This garden is situated in the former foreign settlement built here after the port of Nagasaki opened up to the world. Western-style buildings from the Meiji era were restored and relocated here. Glover House has been designated a UNESCO Cultural Heritage Site. Nagasaki Museum of History and Culture: A museum that conveys the historical and cultural background to Nagasaki's maritime relations with other countries. Nagasaki Shinchi Chinatown: This is one of Japan's three largest Chinatowns. It is built on the former site of the warehouses used by Chinese trading vessels during the age of Japanese national isolation. Nagasaki Peace Park: A solemn place where prayers for peace are offered at an annual ceremony held on 9 August. Nagasaki Atomic Bomb Museum: A museum that conveys the tragic outcome of the atomic bomb dropped on the city and the preciousness of peace. Megane Bridge: This is one of the oldest surviving stone arch bridges in Japan. It acquired its name because the bridge's two arches and their reflection in the water look just like a pair of spectacles (megane). Mount Inasa: This mountain is the symbol of Nagasaki and provides the best view of one of the world's three most impressive urban nightscapes.


LOCATION

Hilton Nagasaki is linked directly to the west side of Nagasaki Station via a pedestrian walkway. The hotel is approximately 45 minutes by limousine bus from Nagasaki Airport to Nagasaki Station. It is conveniently located within walking distance of the nearest tram stop and allows for easy access to the city's main tourist sites. Located next to the Dejima Messe Nagasaki convention centre, it is ideal as a base for tourism and business.







Third Floor
